

## What is the Dakota Energy Cooperative Scholarship Program?

The Dakota Energy Scholarship Program is designed to recognize certain academic achievements by children of member-consumers of Dakota Energy, to encourage students to attend a South Dakota post-secondary institute which we feel will encourage them to stay in South Dakota.

The recognition will be in the form of scholarships.

#### How much is the scholarship?

The Dakota Energy Scholarship Program will award four scholarships in the amount of \$500 each. The scholarships must be used for educational costs, and the student must enter college in the fall of the school year for which the scholarship is given. Checks will be made payable to the student, and will be distributed by Dakota Energy.

### SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Dakota Energy will pay scholarships in two equal installments, the first installment in May and the second installment in December.

## Who is eligible to receive the scholarship?

Dependent children of member-system consumers are eligible. The applicant must also be a U.S. citizen.

The applicant must be a student who is planning to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited, two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational/ technical school located in South Dakota.

#### How are the recipients selected?

Awards are based on the following criteria: ACT score, grade-point average, activities and achievements, a statement of 100 words or less by the student explaining his/her educational and career goals, and two recommendations by third parties.

#### What are the recipient's obligations?

Except for the requirements outlined in this brochure, no obligations will be imposed upon the student as a scholarship award winner. Other than payment of the scholarship, no obligations or liability are assumed by Dakota Energy Cooperative, Inc.

#### How can I apply?

To apply, you must complete the required criteria and the scholarship application, which can be obtained from a cooperative office or from the school counselor.

Children of member-consumers must return applications to a Dakota Energy office at either Miller or Huron by January 30, 2026.

The applicant is responsible for submitting all necessary information to apply for a scholarship.

The applications must reach your cooperative by the given deadline.
